**ORDER**

As per the Proceedings 1<sup>st</sup> cited Sri. T. P. Sudhakaran Field Officer, C-DIT has been re-deployed to Information Kerala Mission in the year 1999 and he is continuing in IKM since then. Now the Government have decided to register Information Kerala Mission as a society under Act 12 of Travancore Cochin Literary and Charitable Societies Act of 1955 and have asked IKM to report the minimum staff strength required for providing support for e-Governance activities of LSGI's. In this circumstance Sri. T. P. Sudhakaran was requested to inform whether he would like to continue as an employee in Information Kerala Mission or to return to his parent organization.

In response to the letter cited above, (ref:-2) Sri. T. P. Sudhakaran has requested to revert him back to his parent Department C-Dit and to relieve him from the service of IKM (ref:- 3). He has also informed that he is willing to work in IKM on deputation from C-Dit, if approved by Government. The issue has been examined in detail and Sri. T. P. Sudhakaran is reverted back to his to parent organization. He has to clear all his liabilities before getting relieved from the service of Information Kerala Mission. His willingness to work in IKM on deputation can be taken up separately.
